Rules and Regulations

1. Foods must be made by 4-H'ers entering exhibit.
2. Each entry must be made from scratch. (min. 5 ingredients)
3. Recipe must accompany each entry. (Neatly written or typed on 3x5 or 4x6 card)
4. All entries must be on a white plate (paper or plastic) and in a clear zip closed bag.

NOTE: Entries will NOT be judged if:

- a) No recipe is included
- b) Not on a plate
- c) Not sealed in a zip plastic bag

4. Each print must be neatly mounted on a white, black or cream-colored mounting board with a 1-inch border. Entries will be displayed using adhesive backed Velcro fasteners
5. Exhibitor is limited to one entry per lot.
