Requirements to maintain individual shows will be a minimum of 15 head and 3 exhibitors for 3 consecutive years.

ALL CATTLE MUST BE PRE-ENTERED.

NO cattle, tack, or trallers will be allowed entry to the fairgrounds until after 6:00am on Thursday, July 27th. Cattle must be in place by 4:00pm Thursday. Tie out time will be at 9:30pm. Failure to abide by this ruling will result in forfeiture of premiums or removal from the fairgrounds. If you have any questions concerning information or problems, see Director, Beef Superintendent.

Cattle will not be released until Saturday, July 29th at 10:00 p.m. or as specified by the Beef Superintendent. All exhibitors must purchase exhibitor's tickets.

Entry fees are due at check in - Cash or check only

Fees - All entries \$6.00 per tie space and \$6.00 per extra tie space if available. Exhibitors tickets - \$10.00.

Supreme champion male and female of all breeds to be selected from all champions. All breed champions are expected to show for supreme male and female following conclusion of Angus show.

Pair is eligible for Grand or Reserve Grand Champion Female. The calf must have the opportunity to nurse. The judge may make his final placing based on these criteria. Cow and/or calf may be included in group class entries as individuals, not as a pair comprising a single animal unit.

47. Produce of Dam: Two animals, either sex, from one dam to be shown in individual classes to be eligible. May be owned by more than one exhibitor.
48. Junior Get-of-Sire: Three animals all by one sire, both sexes represented, may be owned by more than one exhibitor. All animals must be shown in their individual classes to be eligible Bulls from classes 24, 25, 28 or 29. Females from classes 1, 2, 5, or 6.
49. Get-of-Sire: Four animals all by one sire, both sexes represented, may be owned by more than one exhibitor. All animals must be shown in individual classes to be eligible.
50. Breeders Herd: Four animals, either sex, bred and owned by exhibitor. All animals must have shown in individual classes to be eligible.
51. Group of Five Head: Five animals of either sex owned by the exhibitor from either the Calf Classes, Junior Classes, the Senior Classes or a combination.
